We encourage diverse perspectives and opinions and strive for a supportive atmosphere and a true sense of community. Together, we gather new parenting tools and make more informed choices regarding the health, safety and well being of our children.

Fellow Parents Lead the Way

ParentNet meetings are held several times a year at each grade or development level and are led by trained parent volunteers from our school. A faculty advisor attends as a school liaison, assists with school-related questions, and helps clarify the process for further communication and problem solving with the school. Together, we may follow up on important issues, recommend specific parent education programs or initiate new programs to benefit our school community.
